General Information

Pre-health students are those who plan for careers in medicine, pharmacy, dentistry, nursing, physical/occupational therapy, or other health related careers. **Pre-health students can pursue any major, provided they also complete professional school prerequisites.** Admission is determined by many factors, so it is important to balance academic excellence with other commitments.

Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) Credit

Professional health schools vary in how AP and IB credits are accepted. Some may not honor AP or IB credits at all. Please consult with Health Beat at the Career Center for more details on the schools that interest you. In general, you are advised to complete additional coursework in required content areas. Do not repeat credits for which you have received AP or IB credit, because you will not earn additional units or GPA points.
