## Revelle College General Education Requirements

- Students **without** IGETC must complete all of the GE requirements listed below.
- Students **with** IGETC must complete the Mathematics and Natural Science requirements only.
- Students **with Partial** IGETC must complete the Mathematics and Natural Science requirements as well as any missing area(s) to satisfy IGETC.

Met with IGETC	<b>Humanities</b> ( <i>Letter Grade</i> ) A five-course sequence is required: HUM 1 (winter) → HUM 2 (spring) → HUM 3 (fall) → HUM 4 (winter) → HUM 5 (spring)
Required for all Students	<b>Mathematics</b> ( <i>Letter Grade</i> ) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ 2 semesters of Calculus; or</li> <li>○ 2 quarters of Calculus (MATH 10A/20A and MATH 10B/20B) and 1 course selected from MATH 10C, 20C, 11, 18, or PHIL 10.</li> </ul>
Required for all Students	<b>Natural Science</b> ( <i>Letter Grade or P/NP, depending on major requirements</i> ) Five courses in Physical and Biological Sciences, to include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ 1 course in Biology (BILD 1, 2, 3, 7, 10, 12, 20, 22, 26, 30, 32, or 42)</li> <li>○ 1 course in Chemistry (CHEM 4, 6A-C, 6AH-6CH, 11, 12, 13, or 15)</li> <li>○ 1 course in Physics (PHYS 1A-1C, 2A-2D, 4A-4E, 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, or 13)</li> <li>○ 2 courses from Biology, Chemistry, Physics, or Environmental Sciences (ESYS 10 or SIO 1, 3, 10, 12, 15, 16, 20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 50, 60), or PHIL 12</li> </ul>
Met with IGETC	<b>Social Science</b> ( <i>Letter Grade</i> ) Two courses, upper or lower division, selected from the list of approved departments. Upper division courses may not overlap with major requirements.
Met with IGETC	<b>Fine Arts</b> ( <i>Letter Grade or P/NP</i> ) One course, 2-4 units, selected from Music, Theatre, Dance, or Visual Arts. Upper division courses may not overlap with major requirements.
Met with IGETC	<b>Foreign Language</b> ( <i>Letter Grade or P/NP</i> ) Proficiency demonstrated by exam or completion of a fourth quarter or third semester (intermediate level) course.
