

Advanced Placement Credit: College and Major Exemptions



The University of California grants credit for all College Board Advanced Placement Tests on which a student scores 3 or higher.

The credit may be subject credit for use on a minor or prerequisites to a major, or credit toward general-education requirements or elective units toward graduation.
