Paper 3

Essays are due at the beginning of lecture on **Friday, June 2nd**. The paper should be a minimum of 5 full pages in length (no more than 7) in the Humanities format.* A *counterargument* is required. When composing your essay pay particular attention to the Word Choice handout.

Respond to one of the following prompts:

1. Is treachery always wrong? If it is, why? If not, why not? Compare and contrast the answers to these questions found in two of the following texts: *The Voyages of Sindbad*, *The Song of Roland*, the *Lais of Marie de France*, Dante's *Inferno*.
2. What role does suffering play or what is the function of suffering in Dante's spiritual journey?

Submit your paper to your TA in a plain manila folder with your name on the tab. Include all your previous Humanities papers in the folder.

Before submitting a paper copy at lecture, you must submit an electronic copy to www.turnitin.com for text-similarity review.
