- A. Triton Food Pantry Presentation
 - Daniel Juarez, AS President and Justin Perrish, AS Financial Controller
 - Mission: Provide discreet/reliable space for students to address food insecurity
 - Receive delivery from Garden of Eden, and SD Food Bank
 - This year: added pop-up pantries, and produce
 - This quarter had the most visits yet, with Revelle composing largest number
 - UCOP Funds: Started with Global Food Initiative Fund
 - ❖ Next year is last time will receive \$151,000 (not entirely to Food Pantry) from them, and future plans won't be clear until end of this school year/start of next
 - Fundraising
 - ❖ Raised over \$9000 last year
 - ❖ Planning more efforts this year, and reaching out for donations
 - Uncertainty with future funds, so determining potential solutions now
 - ❖ Rethink/considering what we want the pantry to encompass in the future
 - Basic Needs coordinator: will have several student interns
 - Multi-year lock-in with AS
 - ❖ \$30,000 for next three years
 - ❖ AS Pay for two salaries, rest paid for by UCOP
 - Requesting/considering \$3,000 - \$5,000 from each college
 - Will not be running on a deficit the next academic school year
