* Accuracy of Covid Dashboards

- The website is updated daily but may not reflect people who have checked out early once cleared and the expedited cleaning that is happening (rooms are cleaned as soon as they are vacated instead of the next day). Currently, we have 214 spaces and are adding 25 more on Friday and there were 17 spaces available as of last (Tuesday) evening.
- as close to accurate as we can get given how fast people move in and out and the daily update to the dashboard and this is managed by our campus health partners.
- Quite a bit of lag on the waste water dashboard as it takes time to collect, transport, test, and update the dashboard, so be sure to test!
