E. Associated Students Revelle College Senators [Dylan Hahn and Kathleen Nguyen]

- Constitutional Overhaul:
 - Reformation of stipends by introducing levels of stipends with wages increasing as workload and responsibilities increase
 - Change in individual responsibilities of senators (office hours & community engagement)
 - Change the number of senators from 2 to 1, off-campus reps from 2 to 1 and increase campus-wide senators from 5 to 8 (let us know/give us feedback as we have not casted our votes yet!)
 - Reasoning to reform is to increase campus-wide representation, difficult to maintain so many senators with increasing colleges, imbalance work between co-senators, and wanting to minimize cliques within college senators
- Election Reform Overhaul:
 - Longer campaign weeks (change to three weeks), longer hiring process
 - Change to appointment time from week 8 to week 10 to accommodate being rushed into positions during midterm/finals
- Standing Rules Reform:
 - Alterations to executive power such as the authority to determine staff composition in their office to a certain extent
 - Changes to individual rules and responsibilities of cabinet/executive/senate members(a lot of minor individual changes such as adding specific powers for situations not in standing rules, and providing areas for more public input/report of academic misdemeanors/misconduct in the Office of Academic Affairs)
