

 - > Focus on testing, communication training, data and immediate pay in order to ensure smooth functioning at UC San Diego
 - > For testing conversion testing, payroll parallel testing, user testing, metrics/dashboard, data

 - > For immediate pay rapid response center, early detection, student fast lane, pay cards
 - > UC San Diego will issue payment locally if there is a problem
- UC Regents
 - ➤ Meeting next week, will be voting on a variety measures, including basic needs provisions, UCOP budget & entrance exams for upcoming years
- Admissions
 - UC Regents thinking of phasing out SAT/ACT over five years & replacing it with a UC test
 - ➤ Committee is opposed to this reform right now, believing it is too soon
- ❖ IdeaWave campaign for UC San Diego as an HSI
- ❖ Academic Senate does not seem inclined to extend P/NP grading option flexibility afforded this quarter into the summer
- CARES Act Funding
 - ➤ CARES Act funding already deposited into the accounts of students whose EFC is \$0 (~6000 students) as well as those whose EFC is less than \$1000-2000 (~7000 students)
 - > CARES money already almost entirely allocated
- Still no update on CAPS Fee Referendum voting threshold
- ❖ AS funding webinar is available to watch for information about funding in the fall
- Educational Continuity
 - Presentation to Educational Continuity Workgroup by epidemiologists & public health experts on campus
 - Schedule of classes will be released soon to reflect remote education and social distancing
 - ➤ University is working for all new students to have at least 50% of classes not remote
 - ➤ Modeling will aim to control mini-outbreaks as they arise, not to stop them entirely
 - ➤ Mandatory quarantining is being considered, but lawyers are being consulted first about the legality of different control measures
 - > Global health team may come in to answer questions

 - Chancellor Khosla is among the ten UC chancellors, along with UC President Janet Napolitano, taking a voluntary 10% pay cut to help offset losses from the pandemic
 - **❖** Admissions Testing

- > UCOP motion to phase out SAT/ACT & replace it with UC Regents test (wow, that was fast)
- > The SAT/ACT will be phased out and fully replaced over a five year period
- > ETS, the developer of the SAT, among other exams, would help develop this exam
- The UC Regents had commissioned a Standardized Testing Taskforce has been researching how to address issues associated with the SAT/ACT, and they have concluded there is no way to improve standardized testing
- ➤ The UC San Diego Admissions Committee believes UCOP interpreted this incorrectly, believes this is a political move and will likely draft their own resolution against it
- ❖ The Academic Senate will likely approve the capped major system permanently & therefore Admissions Committee will be making some specific recommendations about what this system should look like
- Return to Learn & Epidemiology
 - ➤ Meeting with epidemiologists who are working on the modeling and development of policies in the "Return to Learn" plan for reopening campus
 - > Testing efforts on campus began for symptomatic people only
 - Very few students have needed isolation housing, since the number of cases on campus have been very low
 - > San Diego seems to be doing well in managing the outbreak of the virus
 - ➤ The major problem for San Diego is how the virus is spreading concerningly in Tijuana
 - UC San Diego is providing the tertiary care hospital which is treating a lot of severe coronavirus patients
 - > For UC San Diego testing, students have to be identified first
 - Nasal swab tests are being used right now (both nostrils)
 - May switch to saliva testing, but Return to Learn will finish nasal swabs
 - The university has to test a large number of students for any successful reopening, and it is important to do it through self-testing to preserve PPE
 - ➤ App modified to allow tracking test results, based on a QR code on the bag with the sample, but label is there anyway with identifiable information
 - > There will be no mandatory quarantine for students coming from
 - > Temperature checks are not effective solution, due to the incubation period before displaying symptoms and asymptomatic cases
 - The current Return to Learn program requires a smartphone (on campus residents) to check results of testing
 - > Isolated students have meals delivered & get calls from SHS once a day
 - > The campus labs are developing their own tests
 - > The contact tracing infrastructure is quite strong and is good to go
 - This whole screening process is for non-symptomatic people, symptomatic people have to go to a provider
 - > False positives not a problem for nucleic acid testing (only way that this could happen is with mixing up samples OR contamination)
 - > The antibody tests being administered by UC San Diego are good
 - > False negatives are a problem with biology, as the virus has not made its way up to the nose or mouth
 - Waiting longer to reopen does not necessarily make sense because of a fundamental uncertainty
 - > The model itself and other information from this epidemiological team should be released soon
- ❖ AS end of the year feedback survey coming, \$10 gift cards will be given to the first few hundred participants
- ❖ There will be an update soon on P/NP grading soon for the fall
- Campus privacy and security experts are coming in to present to the Senate next week, so if you have any questions regarding those subject areas let us know!
- Relief Funds
 - ➤ The Senate, after long a discussion, unanimously approved a \$1000000 financial relief effort yesterday, which allocates money for disadvantaged students for financial relief due to COVID-19

- ➤ Four funds of \$250000 are being established to distribute grants for undocumented students, international students, students with basic needs, and support for CAPS
- Campus partners like the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarships will aid in the distribution

AS President collaborating with Black Student Union

- President Giangtran is working with the Black Student Union to help encourage professors to practice compassion during this time and encouraging more leniency during finals week.
- Planning on working with the admin from the return to learn program to expand it to students who are participating in the protest happening right now to show ucsd solidarity to this situation.
- professors usually respond to students that they "don't have the power," however professors actually tons of rights can do whatever they want, as outlined in letter from academic Senate (http://senate.ucsd.edu/current-affairs/news-announcements/support-for-students-during-finals)

ZoomBombing Incident

- Found the person's internet address, perpetrators not from UCSD, website for links
- Three steps that caused incident
 - The meeting was unintentionally shared on social media
 - The meeting was not restricted to authenticated users
 - The host's personal meeting ID was used, allowing the bombers to remain in the meeting.
 - Outcome: Based on the data we have, the responsible parties were not members of the UCSD community and all connections were made from within the Middle East.
- The FBI was brought in on the investigation
- Response
 - ITS: determines identity of responsible parties
 - Community response: equity, diversity, inclusion (EDI); student affairs, OPHD
 - Violence: ITS shares reports with UCPD and FBI
- Prevention

- Closed meetings: known communities, only authenticated users, don't use personal meeting ID
- Open meetings: public access, use password, waiting room, again don't use personal meeting ID
- What to do
 - Meeting owner should block and remove offending user
 - Save chat transcript and start recording, note names
- Report to "zoombombing@ucsd.edu," attach chat transcript/recording, meeting ID and time; can also go advanced settings -> usage, for reports

 - ➤ <u>Community Relations</u> under the VCSA goes to serving underrepresented groups at UCSD as well as connecting the school with the larger San Diego community as a whole, such as funding UCSD's space in the MLK parade. While any student at UCSD can attend these events, the funding itself is limited to cultural student organizations on campus. While the allocation is small in terms of this unit's budget as well as the whole SSF fund, in regards to planning an event as a student org, there is a large difference between having \$100 versus \$200 available for expenses. Student participation in these events is difficult to calculate since the fund goes to many different operations that most likely intersect; there will be a potential follow up to see a rough estimate of this.
 - ➤ <u>Department Support</u> has 3 to 4 main expenses: SPACES support (330k), USS Lawyer (135k), NCAA Representative (60k), and ISPO Peer Mentors (46k).
 - The recurring commitment to SPACES came as a result of the Compton Cookout, as well as various studies showing that a critical mass of a group was needed to make a community. in 2017, only 1.3% of the undergraduate student population at UCSD was Black, with those students reporting that they didn't feel a sense of community around campus. SPACES goes towards helping underrepresented students into higher education at the high school level, as opposed to OASIS who focuses on that same population after already attending UCSD.
 - The USS Lawyer is funded separately from the rest of the center since the organization supplying the lawyer is currently undergoing contract negotiations with the UC/UCD. This lawyer provides legal support to any undocumented students (and their family)

- attending UCSD, such as getting documented, legal protections and rights while on campus in UCSD and elsewhere.
- NCAA rep. travels and maintains UCSD's NCAA membership, partially funded by the VCSA.
- ISPO Peer Coaches have presented in the past and have had great success in helping international students both connect with domestic students as well as simply feeling like a more cohesive part of campus; other services include assistance for attending UCSD and providing general, trained mentorship
- The only variable parts of <u>Division Support</u> are that of the graduate assistantships, as legal expenses are a standard charge directly to UCOP General Counsel for legal services rendered. With regards to the assistantship program, more specificity about the program is needed through potentially a follow up meeting in order to determine in what department these graduates are funded and in which particular positions (teaching, research, etc), as well as eligibility. It is worth noting that the allocation for this program has already been contracted down by half, down to 40k.
- Employee Support goes towards administration, funding union support for employees (such as collective bargaining), team and personal staff development opportunities, and maintaining proper and healthy working environments. While not directly related to students, it is still a non-academic necessity and eligible for SSF funding, and less administrative support impacts students in the form of having less and/or slower infrastructure to support them if administrative productivity goes down, harming overall student satisfaction and experience.
- Facilities maintains itself separately from the school's <u>Facilities</u>
 <u>Management</u> unit, and focuses on Student Center B, the Student Services
 Center, and emergency repairs and temporary assistance. Missing from the
 expenses is the revenue coming from the Yogurt-World and Croutons
 tenants back into maintaining the Student Services Center for student use
 with the meeting and multipurpose rooms, as well as the student
 employment within those stores. The facilities allocation was cut by half
 (150k) last year, with any additional contractions being unstable as they
 would have to come from reserves.
- Memberships and Software is a smaller point, with the most notable being the Triton Concern Line, primarily used by Case Management Services. Due to the push last year for mental health by students, as well as this concern line being for professors to be able to refer students, it seems like a valuable resource. While it may be more difficult for professors to be able to use this during remote learning, looking ahead to returning to in person classes makes this service invaluable for staff and faculty to be able to provide help to potential students of concern.

 - Risks to the forecast remain higher than usual and economic inequality has intensified since the pandemic began
 - Expenditures are projected to grow faster than revenues with a structural deficit of 7.6 billion projected for 2022-23 that is forecast to grow over \$11 billion
 - University of California
 - \$3.819B in recurring funds
 - ◆ +3.6% increase in academic campuses (127.4M)

 - > THIS IS LESS THAN WHAT WAS CUT IN SPRING 2019
- Regents requested \$518.3M recurring funds, \$250M of one time funds (less than half of requested)
- Budget Bill Language
 - Holds tuition flat for 2021-22.
 - Takes action to close "equity gaps" by 2025, works with CCC and CSU to share metrics and plans
 - Increase the number of online learning opportunities by 10% by June 2022
 - Better align student learning objectives with workforce needs
 - Develop dual admissions pathway for first time-CCC freshman to receive guaranteed admission to UC. This will be a trailer bill, but language is not written yet
- \$136.3M of New Recurring Funds "NEW"
 - \$103.9 mil for a 3% base budget increase for the campuses and UCOP. This would be a partial restoration of the \$300 million cut UC sustained in FY 2020-21
 - \$12.9 mil for UC Prime (for medical students)
 - \$15 mil for basic needs to focus on SMH and technology
 - \$1.5 mil for Immigrant Legal Services located in UC Davis
 - \$1 mil for transition to Canvas
- \$225.3M of One Time Funds
 - \$175 mil for deferred maintenance / energy efficiency
 - \$20 mil for
 - \$15 mil for emergency fin aid
 - \$5 mil for cultural competent
- Impact: Academic and Student Affairs.
 - RESTORES cal grants, INCREASE \$35 mil to gf of cal grant, INCREASE \$20 mil for cal grant for former or foster youth, REQUIRES local educational agencies to confirm that all high school seniors complete a FAFSA and CDA.
- Impact on UCSD 2021-22 budget process
 - State cut 10% of budget last year
 - Due to the distribution of state gf within the UC system (some schools receive more per student than others), UCSD implemented a 4% core fund cut


