Revelle College General Education Requirements

Please refer to the Revelle website for approved course lists. Credits for AP exams, IB exams, and community college courses will be applied wherever appropriate.

Humanities *(Letter Grade)*

A five-course sequence is required:

HUM 1 (winter) → HUM 2 (spring) → HUM 3 (fall) → HUM 4 (winter) → HUM 5 (spring)

Mathematics *(Letter Grade)*

2 quarters of Calculus (MATH 10A/20A and MATH 10B/20B) and 1 course selected from MATH 10C, 20C, 11, 18, or PHIL 10.

Natural Science *(Letter Grade or P/NP, depending on major requirements)*

Five courses in Physical and Biological Sciences, to include:

- 1 course in Biology (BILD 1, 2, 3, 7, 10, 12, or 26)
- 1 course in Chemistry (CHEM 4, 6A-C, 11, 12, 13, or 15)
- 1 course in Physics (PHYS 1A-1C, 2A-2D, 4A-4E, 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, or 13)
- 2 courses from Biology, Chemistry, Physics, or Environmental Sciences (SIO 10, 12, 15, 20, 25, 30)

Social Science *(Letter Grade)*

Two courses, upper or lower division, selected from the list of approved departments. Upper division courses may not overlap with major requirements.

Fine Arts *(Letter Grade or P/NP)*

One course, 2-4 units, selected from Music, Theatre, Dance, or Visual Arts. Upper division courses may not overlap with major requirements.

Foreign Language *(Letter Grade or P/NP)*

Proficiency demonstrated by exam or completion of a fourth quarter level course.

- 2.0 minimum GPA
- 180 cumulative units, including 60 upper division units
