 - ❖ OASIS
 - > 2 main programs that they wish to focus on
 - Hope Scholars Program is for mainly former foster youth but has expanded to students with large, disruptive trauma. Out of the 150 former foster students at UCSD, Hope Scholars reaches 76 of them (more than half) exclusively by referrals and word of mouth
 - This is a high funding priority since the foundation that supplies the funding is ending this year, would take about 50K from core funds supplied by SSF and is higher priority over new OASIS proposal
 - Two pilot programs
 - Lab training and certification, works through 6 clinics and could only take 65 out of the 120 applicants.
 - Of the 30K funding overall, half is from EDI and the other half is matched by OASIS from core funds
 - Transfer-to-Career Program servicing 35 of the 76 applicants utilizing peer mentors and CSC advisors to have transfer students acquire gainful employment by the end of their years at UCSD

- Of the 40K funding overall, half is EDI and the other half is again matched by OASIS from core funds
- New proposed expansion of the Summer Bridge program, specializing in transfer students as well as getting students careers after college by working extensively with UCSD and CSC
 - Looks to service about 100 students and requires 300K in funding from UCSD, lower priority than the Hope Scholars Funding

ISPO

- ➤ ISPO is piloting a new Peer Coaching program to help service these students socially as opposed to just professionally
 - Has 10 trained coaches with each coach servicing about 80-90 students, responsibilities are more academic in nature, such as referring students to the proper channels and helping students wade through a first year of college life
 - Program is initially opt-in to first get involved, then students get reached out to over the summer
 - Goal of the program is to service about 500 students by the end of 2022, with about 20-25 Coaches working with 25 and 20 students respectively
 - Cost of program is currently unknown as this is the first quarter of a year long pilot program

AEP

- Services students through a host of student participated conferences and research opportunities, as well as various scholarships and referrals to faculty members and professors.
- ➤ Does not have any specific requests for funding currently, as a large part of the funding is through other scholarships or grants given by private donors
- ➤ Goal is to service about 15% of the undergraduate population, but no specified timeline for that goal

❖ SVRC

- ➤ Hired another FTE with funding recommended to VC office last year by SFAC
- ➤ Has potential populace of 450 students that are ROTC, family members of military personnel, or veterans/service(wo)men themselves
 - Currently is reaching $\frac{1}{2}$ (150) of those students, but the ideal goal is to reach $\frac{1}{2}$ (225)
- Use majority of funding on the 2 FTEs and Peer Navigator and Military ALLY programs
 - With more funding, would like to go and do more outreach at the community/junior college level and work with the student veterans organizations already established there
 - Physical space is also a concern for them, and would like to potentially move


