  - student employment (works with  $\sim$ 10,000 student workers)
  - student engagement (coach and advise on jobs, internships, grad school, business development, etc.)
- ➤ Features career peers that advise fellow students in one-on-one sessions that require no appointments and take brunt of the CC workload
- > Every cultural center is assigned a career peer from the Career Center to make sure they hear student feedback from that particular partition of campus on challenges and lack of necessary resources
- ➤ Events:
  - Take a Triton to Work (500 alumni and 500 students matched to shadow a particular business interest and also to develop a connection)
  - Tritons Connect: application open to all students and alumni to be connected via personal or professional interests; students can also find potential mentors
- > Looking for more funding to be able to work within the colleges directly as well as more student engagement representatives to work in disciplines as well, essentially just want to hire more FTE to service more students

#### **❖** SHS

- > Services primary patients at UCSD within ages 18-24 with approximately 47,000 visits per year
- ➤ the building in mostly self sufficient
  - X-ray facilities
  - Lab following CA and US regulations
  - Pharmaceutical services
  - Urgent care services or referrals to UCSD Med
  - Insurance department
  - Optometry
- > SHIP and RAFT cover copays and all visits are free
- > 100% of Student Health funding is from student services fees and also goes towards mental health, counseling, and psychological services. even without SHIP or RAFT, services will cost about ½ of what private services would charge
- ➤ Want to expand to sports medicine physicians and gynecologist, requests unknown outside of this (more clinicians/nurses?)

#### Update on AEP

- ➤ Requesting an event planner to be able to focus solely on hosting the event so the rest of the AEP staff can focus on filling it with students/speakers and advertising/holding spots for other universities to come in, both domestic and international
- ➤ Want to expand the UC Summer Scholars program as it's one of the main programs that doesn't take state/federal funding and thus one of the few research opportunities open to international students, working with SFAC professional staff and ISPO in a collaboration to try and double the number of available spots.
