 - Craft Night Event went well! There was a good turnout and everyone learned lots from our speaker from The Hub.

 - ➤ Highest priority is the Production Manager, with this being able to free up about \$100K and allowing about 20 more events this quarter alone
 - Grad Division
 - ➤ Is an initial pilot program to have these and then cost will be absorbed by the Grad Division
 - ➤ Currently, Career Center has only 4 people for graduate students, this is to bump the number of GCPE from 1 to 5 to serve the 8,500 graduate students at UCSD; goal is to help graduate students get careers; over 50% are international
 - ➤ The breakdown is as follows
 - Engineering GCPE for ISOE
 - Life Sciences for Biological/Health Sciences
 - Physical Sciences for Physical Sciences and SIO
 - Non-STEM for literally anything non-STEM
 - ➤ Complaints about the size of JSOE creating the most strain on graduate school and that priorities are not in the proper spots, with non-STEM having a only 50% satisfaction rating

 - SHIP (I mentioned these proposals before but I'm going to put it again because there are new details that have been added to it. These proposals are at an all UC-level)
 - ➤ 1. International claims
 - Cover all international services at the PPO coinsurance level and paid based on 100% of billed charges after \$500 deductible
 - > 2. Increase Psychoeducational Testing Lifetime Maximum to \$4,500
 - Covered by UC SHIP with a \$3K lifetime
 - Maximum
 - Lifetime maximum protects the plan from billing abuse
 - Average billed/allowed in network (2016-18): \$912
 - Average billed out of network (2016-2018): \$2,858
 - 0.02% increase to plan (not set in stone and depends on utilization)
 - > 3. Facial Feminization/ Masculinization Procedure
 - Pricing assumes the following covered services (provided by Anthem):

- Male to Female:
 - Thyroid Chondroplasty, brow lift, forehead contouring, malar (cheek) implants, jaw and or chin reshaping, lip shortening, scalp advancement, rhinoplasty
- Female to male:
 - ◆ Augmentation thyroid chondroplasty, chin implant and or genioplasty, jaw implant
- Increases premium to 0.3% but might increase more later on
- This is not a standard benefit and there is a concern that if the IRS considers this cosmetic, there could be tax penalties to the student.
- > 4. SB159: Pharmacist dispensed 30-60 day supply of PrEP or PEP
 - PrEP (pre-exposure prophylaxis) or PEP (post exposure prophylaxis) is the use of anti-HIV medication that keeps HIV negative people from becoming infected
 - Authorizes pharmacist to provide a 30-60 day supply of PrEP or PEP without a prescription
 - Prohibits insured health plans from implementing prior authorization or step therapy
