 - > Send in Event Flyer, Post Caption, and posting schedule at least 4 days before the event. The goal for this is:
 - For the first 24 hours, the VPE is able to receive the message and observe if any changes need to be made (typos/inappropriate messaging/missing-information) + schedule the post upload.
 - To have a minimum of 3 days of consistent advertisement to highlight your event.
 - ➤ If you expect to potentially take vids/photos of participation during the event to publicize it more, let me know ahead of time to see if I can have my schedule clear to repost.
