- ❖ Last report as international representative: On Tuesday, May 27, U.S. Embassies and consulates were reportedly instructed to pause new F, M, and J visa appointments. This is part of a possible expansion in social media screening and vetting for visa applicants. The ISEO is actively monitoring the situation and will share updates as they come. In the meantime, they will continue to issue I-20 (F-1) and DS-2019 (J-1) forms to support students preparing for interviews. This news is especially difficult for J-1 visa holders, who must renew their visas yearly in order to travel and re-enter the U.S. If you're a J-1 holder planning summer travel, please be cautious. More broadly, I urge all international students, regardless of visa status, to stay safe.

Check in with your embassy, ISEO, and academic advisors if you're unsure about your status or plans.

- H. Associated Students Revelle College Senators [Christina Rodriguez, Ludwig Bartels]
 - Senate Updates:
 - > Senator Rating:
 - Christina: 7/10, bit longer than usual and a few items were added to the agenda last minute, but overall felt productive
 - SPECIAL PRESENTATION
 - SPECIAL PRESENTATION: Basic Needs Hub Mandate Reserves Funding Request in the amount of \$40,000. Sponsored by Chief Financial Officer Hoang.
 - Basic Needs Hub Presentation
 - Basic Needs Hub, known for helping students experiencing homelessness and food insecurity
 - ◆ The Hub Basic Needs Center has helped 1 out of 5 students of the entire UC San Diego Student Population
 - ◆ The budget shortfall this year is due to the 5% increase of funds meant to be allocated to student basic needs being deferred for the last couple of years
 - ◆ Chancellor agreed to match 40k to allocate to the Basic Needs Hub
 - However, it was only a handshake deal, there is nothing set in stone yet.
 - SPECIAL PRESENTATION: AS Office of Student Organizations: Non-UCSD Attendance. Motion by Chief Financial Officer Hoang.
 - Non-UCSD Attendance
 - Urging AS to consider non-UCSD affiliates be able to join UCSD events, despite them being sponsored by student fees
 - Main Claims:
 - ➤ Noticeable drop-off in attendance
 - Prospective students could attend a event and convince them to attend/apply to UCSD
 - ➤ AS Office Reports:
 - Revelle College:
 - Statement on our disappointment with the resolution, but overall support for AAPI and initiatives that uplift the AAPI community.
 - Marshall College:
 - Denied AAPI resolution due to lack of action items
 - ◆ Senator Sitanggang: Statement necessary to support and acknowledge AAPI communities as a whole. Not enough resources allocated. Meant to express a united belief. This resolution is meant only as a first step. Opens the door to communication and allows for future change to be
