 - Appointment of Elsabella Wang as ASUCSD Judicial Board Chief Justice (Article IV ASUCSD Constitution). Sponsored by President Vallejo-Avila.
 APPROVED
- FINANCE ACTION ITEM: 2024-2025 Executive Budget Presentation. Sponsored by Chief Financial Officer Hoang.
 - For newbies, Associated Students is the campus-wide student government on campus
 - We currently manage a budget of \$8.8 million and are primarily funded by student fees
 - Around Week 5 of Fall Quarter (every year), AS Senate holds a super long meeting(s) to determine how to allocate that allocated money
 - In the meantime, AS is currently facing a 700k deficit
 - HOWEVER, I successfully advocated to increase funding for the grant initiative fund under the Office of College Affairs (money that RCC and other councils will be able to access for cross college collaborations and projects focusing on basic needs, sustainability, health, etc.
 - a. The proposed line item was 25k and the original ask was 50 BUT I motioned to increase the line item to 45k
 - We made it roughly half through the budget talks BUT the talks will probably be difficult given how the Senate is expected to close the 700k deficit the Association is facing
 - I motioned to postpone until next week's Senate meeting (November 6th) we ended around 10:30/10:45 pm

- My resolution for Geisel Library reducing its hours will be presented to the Senate for a complete vote next week! It passed unanimously through the Legislative Committee
- I'm also drafting a basic needs-related resolution focused on data collection (I will submit the resolution by the end of the week to AS for review then a vote by Week 7)
- NOTE: I'll attach the final budget that's approved after next week's Senate meeting when it's finalized
