What are all the Student Fees that students pay per quarter and what is SFAC?

- This screenshot gives a brief rundown of all of the student fees that students get charged each quarter and what campus wide board is in charge of handling these fees.
- ❖ SFAC (Student Fee Advisory Committee), is in charge of a separate fee called the "Student Service Fee" which is worth \$430 a quarter. SFAC is in charge of a fund that is worth approximately \$300,000, and uses this money to fund programs or initiatives that faculty members, or other UC San Diego affiliated groups present before the Committee.
- During the Winter, we hear these proposals, and rank which Programs and Initiatives we believe will strongly benefit the Student Population.
- This past week, we participated in training where we read previous years' proposals and practiced asking questions.
- Over the course of the next SFAC meetings in the fall quarter, we will be oriented to reviewing a variety of proposals and representing the interests of Revellians there.
- ❖ We will not hear the 2024-2025 proposals until next quarter, but rest assured we will be sure to bring the proposals to Council and ask for your feedback (via Straw Polls) to make sure that we accurately reflect the wants and needs of the Revelle Population!


