      - ◆ Nic: I agree with the sentiment of the resolution since students on our campus voiced the same opinion and RCC signed onto a vote of no confidence against Chancellor Khosla for the same reason; however, I voted to postpone just to ensure the resolution doesn't constitute libel and to ensure the Association is legally safe from any lawsuit from the university based on false statements. etc.


