- 2025-26 Innovation Grants have been released and SFAC has been reviewing them since the past two weeks. Eight proposals have been discussed so far, with 4 remaining

 - > 3 options



 - National College Health Assesment (NCHA)
 - lengthy but comprehensive survey sent out to a select sample of ~12,000 students in different colleges/universities
 - Used to gauge the well being of students (including gen. Health questions, sexual behaviors, birth control usage, fruit/veg intake, habits (alcohol,tabacco,vaping, etc.), and mental health q's (ex. Lonleyness level))

 - Main Dilemma: not many students participate (in the past, about 7-8% of students participated)
 - difficult to advertise, since only a select group of students receive the survey
 - Social media was suggested (like a flyer or something of the sort) - was not entirely turned down, but not very inclined (since its only to certain students)
 - Incentives:
 - ◆ Should there be a physical (items discussed: Owallas, Digi Cams, College Merch etc.),digital (ex. Amazon gift cards), or mix of both as a prize?
 - ◆ Leaned towards mix of both
 - Discussion of whether there should be a giveaway of a big/expensive item, but also have a guaranteed prize for all who participate (ex. \$5 gift card)
 - ◆ Still a WIP, but if you have suggestions I could bring up at the next meeting, please let me know!!
 - Emergency Department Usage
 - Misuse of the Emergency department :((
 - The price of UC Ship Premium increased because of inappropriate usage of the ED
 - Caused long waits (even up to a day's worth)
 - Determined by staff who categorized the conditions of each patient (critical,emergent,urgent,semi-urgent, urgent)
 - Students end up overpaying for their condition (urgent care co-pay vs ER co-pay)
 - Solutions:
 - UCSD SHS implemented a telehealth advice line: 859-534-3000 (press 2 to speak w/ RN)
 - (free to use no matter your insurance) to ask where to go or what care you can do to self-treat
 - Follow up line: After calling the advice line, a nurse will check up on you a few days later to make sure you got the care you needed/general check in
 - Dillema: How do we get students to know these resources exist??
 - Creation of an easy to read infographic that can be

reposted on social media and printed/posted by ResLife and hung in common spaces or res halls/distributed to residents (*WIP*)
