Reasoning: After lots (and lots, and lots) of internal back and forth, I ultimately decided to unfreeze the VPEA's account, along with the majority of the Senate. While I wholeheartedly disagree with the action to buy flights prior to official university approval because there are severe consequences should this \$5k not be returned to A.S., I agree with the public comments that the External

office and the conferences it hosts and sends Senate to are beneficial to students if they are able to attend.

- ➤ That said, I am going to push very hard for new, stricter spending guidelines to be put on the offices who hold purchasing power as well as pushing for more administrative oversight.

While I had a lot of frustration and anger with the misuse of the funds, I believe we all make mistakes and it'd be the best course of action to work with the VPEA to establish much stricter guidelines and training for expenditures. I want to make it clear that I unequivocally disagree with the mishaps with buying the tickets before final approval. However, I will be pushing for much, much stricter guidelines alongside the rest of the Exec and Senate.
