 - No research to back up claims in the proposal

 - Some very useful and important information about why Basic Needs decided to launch this survey from Carmen, our program coordinator:

Through the Winter and Spring quarter, we have been meeting with the College Basic Needs Representatives to create a student led basic needs assessment that would help us grow a deeper understanding of students evolving challenges with basic needs among the college neighborhoods. While supporting the College Basic Needs Representatives of each college, we noticed a common challenge being uplifted by the Representatives not having access to student data to help direct them on how to best support their fellow peers and the desired need to assess the current need within their colleges. Representatives also uplifted challenges when it came to receiving funding for programs that would be greatly beneficial to capacity build basic needs supplemental resources to their localized college neighborhood communities.

The goal of the "College Call to Action- Basic Needs Survey" is to help College Basic Needs Representatives by learning more about the student needs of the individual colleges in order to give students the resources to hold programs specific to their college

needs. Additionally, the intention of this survey is to round out the UC Undergraduate Experience Survey (UCUES) which seeks to guide the University for the holistic improvement of the Undergraduate Experience by reporting on the quality of academic programs to the University's Academic Senate. The "College Call to Action- Basic Needs Survey" expands on this by taking a closer look at students' basic needs and the programs they are looking for to address these problems reflective of their college neighborhood experience.
