- Sen. Tappin working with VPAA Yalamarty on a resolution regarding Geisel Library hours being cut
  - a. Just finished a survey

#### **❖** NEW BUSINESS

- Discussion: 2024 -2025 UCSD Changes to Geisel Library Hours & Other Funding Allocations to School Services. Sponsored by: Sen. Bautista, Sen. Zhu.
  - Sen. Bautista:
    - pending request about specifics of budget cuts
    - inquisition is in regard to why specifically hours were cut in the grander context of a decreased state budget

- VPE Tabia-Jr Urbieta
  - Gave context from External office about bills being held up in CA legislature
  - Khosla delegates budget cuts to the VCs and Department Chairs
  - UCOP hands down budget cuts from the State
  - UCSD does not have a budget deficit but the state budget cuts are separate whereby they impact all campuses
- President Vallejo-Avila
  - Believes VPAA has distinct focus on this issue and should coordinate in efforts to keep the library open longer
- Sen. Zhu:
  - Would like to reach out to alternative spaces for students to be able to access, like the resource centers or create a program through Senate to keep study spaces open
- Sen. Garcia:
  - Would like to highlight other 24 hour spaces on campus as well
- Sen. Zapata-Castillo:
  - Ditto to Sen. Zhu's and Sen. Garcia's point, suggested collaboration on doing research to find alternative methods to keep spaces open
- Action: <u>Resolution on the Summer Bridge & Mentor Collective Merger and Collaboration.</u> Sponsored by Sen. Tappin, Sen. Zapata-Castillo, and President Vallejo-Avila.
  - Resolution opposing the merger of the Mentor Collective and the Summer Bridge program
    - Mentor Collective: volunteer based, students are paired with an older student to foster their leadership skills and learn how to enter into and build community at UCSD
    - Summer Bridge: paid student interns are paired with an entering freshman, typically low-income students or first-gen, who is taking a Summer Session class prior to their first year and help them establish themselves at UCSD
    - Discrepancy comes from the fact that:
      - Summer Bridge pays their interns, Mentor Collective does not
      - ◆ Summer Bridge is more academic focused, Mentor Collective focuses on a students' emotional wellbeing
      - ◆ Summer Bridge professional staff are being told to start finding other places of employment


